Foods 1, Clothing 1, and FACS Exploration Disclosure Addendum

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Each of these classes has a \$10.00 fee. The supplies for projects and labs will be provided by the school using these fees.

Foods, Clothing, and FACS Exploration Lab Students are expected to show appropriate behavior while in the lab at all times. Students are expected to be in class on time, follow all lab rules, teacher instructions and requests, respect equipment within the labs, and clean up after themselves. Failure to do so will result in loss of lab privileges. Students will be responsible to replace broken items due to misconduct.

Foods 1 Additional Information

The Food and Nutrition 1 curriculum has expanded to teach the ServSafe Food Handler Curriculum, with the option of earning a ServSafe certificate and Food Handlers Permit. Students will take the ServSafe Food Handlers Test. If they pass with a minimum of 75%, they can choose to pay a \$20 fee to receive a Food Handlers Permit from Salt Lake County (valid for 3 years). If a permit is not ordered by the cut-off date, the student would be required to retake the food handler course through the county.

Note: This certification may be useful to your student if they plan on working in any food establishment in Utah where it is required.
