Congratulations on your decision to join STRIVE! STRIVE stands for Students Teaching Respect, Integrity, Values, and Equality, and its role is to improve our school community through service. Service student leadership will provide you with opportunities that make an impact on our school and the community around us. STRIVE student leaders often set the tone for the school year and the spirit we see here at our school. This year, we want to help make STRIVE more visible by helping and serving our school community and promoting kindness and unity.

Each applicant will be required to adhere to the following criteria:

- You must maintain a GPA of 3.0 while in STRIVE.
- You must maintain good citizenship no N's or U's.
- You must be able to stay after school occasionally to prepare for upcoming activities or to provide leadership help with extracurricular events.
- You must show up for all your commitments or find a reliable sub for occasions when you cannot attend.

The consequence for breaking these expectations will be probation for a minimum of one month. If you fail to improve your grades, citizenship, or fail to follow through on more than three commitments in a row, you will be removed from the STRIVE student leadership team. If you are suspended as a result of school rules infraction, you will be placed on probation for at least one month. If you are suspended due to a safe school violation, you will be removed from STRIVE.
