PTSA student leaders often set the tone for the school year and the spirit we see here at our school. This school year, we want to help make PTSA more visible in helping and serving our school community.

Each applicant will be required to adhere to the following criteria:

- You must maintain a GPA of 3.0 while in PTSA.
- You must maintain good citizenship no N's or U's.
- You must be able to stay after school occasionally to prepare for upcoming activities or to provide leadership help with extracurricular events.
- You must show up for all your commitments or find a reliable sub for occasions when you cannot attend.

The consequence for breaking these expectations will be probation for a minimum of one month. If you fail to improve your grades, citizenship, or fail to follow through on more than three commitments in a row, you will be removed from the PTSA student leadership team.

If you are suspended as a result of school rules infraction, you will be placed on probation for at least one month. If you are suspended due to a safe school violation, you will be removed from PTSA.
