Performing is an essential skill for success (and a good grade) in my classes. Ask your student what they are working on in choir, journalism, music studies or theatre, and ask for a demonstration.

Watching artistic movies (see list below) will be used to fulfill state standards. Movies might include . . .

1. *Titus Andronicus* by William Shakespeare
2. *Taming of the Shrew* by William Shakespeare
3. *Hamlet* by William Shakespeare
4. *Phantom of the Opera* by Gaston Leroux
5. *Driving Miss Daisy* by Alfred Uhry
6. *A Streetcar Named Desire* by Tennessee Williams
7. *Into the Woods* by Stephen Sondheim (or another play by Sondheim that they may want instead)
